



GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The Conference reviewed the deteriorating conditions of the Palestinian cause and the Zionist schemes which aim at judaization of the state, the annexation of Al Aqsa Mosque and considering it a Jewish institution.

The Conference appeals to the Palestinian people in all its factions to stand united against the heinous aggression which targets its very being and its entity, to stop inter-strife, and to gear its struggle against the main enemy, namely, world Zionism and the Israeli State.

The Conference appeals to the Islamic world, its states, peoples and organizations to take the measures that could strengthen the Palestinian society in all domains, and to prepare it for a long-term struggle against the enemy— a struggle in which all mechanisms and tools are used.

2. The Conference supports efforts exerted by Egypt to achieve Palestinian reconciliation. It calls on all parties to sign the Egyptian reconciliation paper giving precedence to higher Palestinian interests over self- interests.
3. The Conference reviewed the bad conditions which the Islamic World undergoes, and the continued conspiracies that beset its countries and peoples. The Conference calls on the Islamic World to unite in the face of these conspiracies and intrigues which target its very being. In this context the Conference calls on:

A- The wise and effective powers in Iran to absorb the recent problems and the conflicts fostered by the enemy.

B- Dealing with the international community and its organizations as regards the nuclear file in a way that keeps up Iran's scientific advancement, and protects it against the intrigues hatched in the lobbies of the major powers for undermining its unity and progress.

4. The Conference confirms President Mubarak's call of rendering the Middle East a zone free from nuclear weapons.
5. The Conference calls upon the Administration of President Obama to pursue the implementation of his promises to abate seditions and defuse conflicts around the world, to work for finding a just solution to the Palestinian question, and to put an end to the military intervention in Afghanistan, Pakistan and Iraq which causes the death of the innocents and disturbs the guiltless people.
6. The Conference calls on the Islamic states to cooperate via the international organizations to put an end to the adverse conditions of Muslims in Somalia and Ethiopia. Conditions which force some of them to disrupt international trade and intercept the ships sailing in the area.
7. The Conference appeals to the Organization of Islamic Conference (OIC) and the affiliated organizations to devise clear plans for discussing the problems of the Islamic communities and figuring out the appropriate solutions to the following problems:
 - ◆ The global economic crisis and the Islamic solutions for this crisis.
 - ◆ Investment of the surplus Islamic money in projects within the Islamic communities to help develop these communities and contribute to their progress.
 - ◆ Development of the OIC agencies and its objectives in a way that responds to the aspirations of the Islamic societies, and protection of their people against all forms of aggression.
